OVER 50,000 CHILDREN ARE REPORTED MISSING EVERY YEAR IN CANADA.

When a child first goes missing, the police, the media and the community all rally together to help the terrified and grieving family search for their child, but as time goes by, that involvement inevitably decreases, leaving the family to continue the search...seemingly alone.

It is for these families that the Missing Children Society of Canada was established in 1986. Our unique and comprehensive search programs assist police and searching families in the active and ongoing search for missing children.

MCSC's team of former police detectives and trained investigators work closely with law enforcement while conducting frontline, hands-on investigation and search activities. This active methodology is the foundation of MCSC and distinguishes us from other organizations with similar mandates. **All services are provided free of charge.**

We support the ongoing search by:

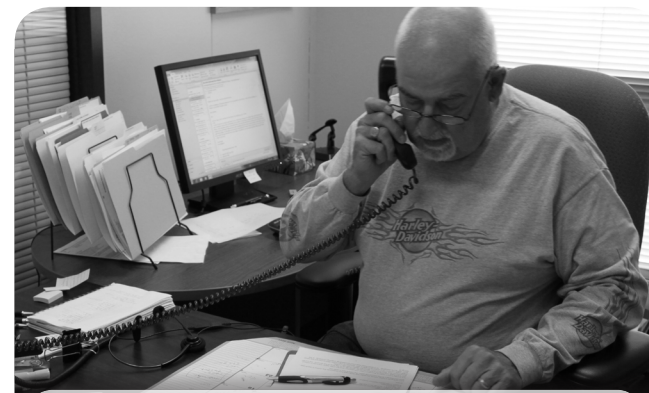
- Travelling nationally and internationally to conduct front-line investigations.
- Operating a 24 hour toll-free tip line for the public to provide confidential information leading to the location of a missing child.
- Maintaining an online directory of our active missing children cases.
- Alerting the media and other contacts across the country of our investigation updates through our **Child Search Alerts™**.
- Producing and distributing missing child posters locally or nation-wide.
- Securing rewards for information leading to the location of a missing child.
- Working with our partner organizations to coordinate and fund ground searches.

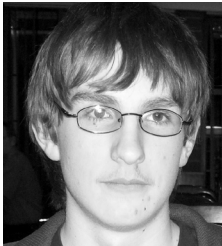
